<p><u>Service Description:</u></p> <p>In addition to its own network of storage and handling facilities which include 111 country silos and 7 export shipping terminals, ABB has a 50% interest in Australian Bulk Alliance (ABA), which it operates. ABA's network covers 7 country silos in Victoria and New South Wales. Through ABA, ABB has a 25% interest in the grain terminal at the Port of Melbourne.</p> <p>ABB has storage and handling agreements in place with more than 50 grain marketers and receives grain from farmers on their behalf in addition to providing warehousing facilities for farmers until they are ready to make a sales decision.</p> <p>ABB has a complex information technology system in place that allows marketers and farmers to get quick and easy access to their grain delivery and receival information over the internet via the company's ezigrain internet site. ABB can boast that in most cases by the time a farmer gets home after delivering a truckload of grain the information about that load, its tonnage and quality characteristics will be available via the internet.</p> <p>Although grain is the core of the storage and handling business the company handles a considerable amount (more than 2 million tonnes) of non-grain commodities such as dolomite, salt and gypsum through its terminal facilities.</p>
