The private schools in the region charge tuition fees, but they are significantly less than those charged in cities in Australia. Innovative, advanced and diverse curricula are offered in the region's public schools. Each regional centre boasts at least one government primary school, with secondary schools easily accessible from all the towns in the region.

Other popular child care options include day-care in a carer's home (family day-care) or privately employed nannies. Commonwealth government assistance is available in certain circumstances and this can reduce the child-care fee depending on the family's income.

Learn then earn.....South Australia has four internationally recognised universities, an extensive vocational training system and a wide range of specialised tertiary institutions. The University of Adelaide, Flinders University and the University of South Australia offer world-class education, with many courses and programs offered externally. TAFE (Technical and Further Education) has two campuses within the Southern Flinders Ranges, in Port Pirie and Jamestown. TAFE provides more than 300 vocational education and training courses designed to meet the demands of the workforce. More than 80 percent of TAFE graduates go on to win employment within six months of graduating—a higher rate than the national average of 75 percent.
