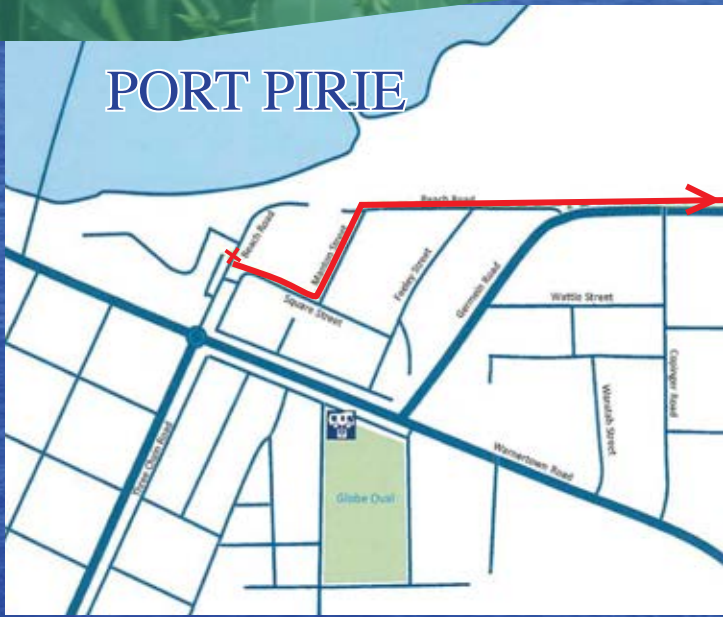
Port Pirie - Napperby Cycle Track 10km

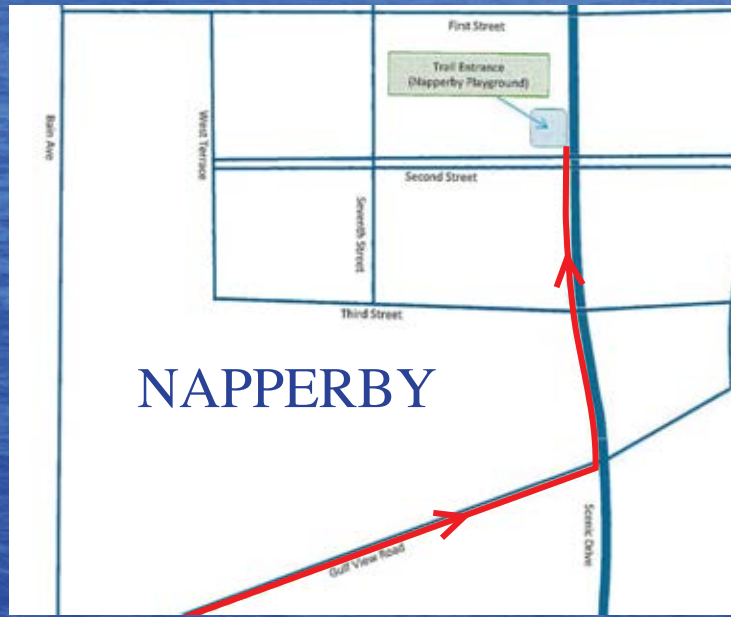
